The Center for English Communication (CEC) at Reitaku University, Kashiwa, Japan invites applications for one lecturer position (koshi) for an initial 2-year term. Successful applicants are expected to be at the university for 9 hours (with a one-hour lunch break) each day from Monday to Friday with occasional weekend Open Campus event assignments. Each week, lecturers are permitted a half-day (four hours) for research during which they are not required to be on campus. Responsibilities include teaching a maximum of ten koma of English proficiency development courses a week for two semesters each year (e.g., Reading & Writing Workshop, English for Communication), being involved in events and activities in the International Lounge (iLounge), materials and curriculum development, conducting and publishing research, assuming university / Hiroike Institute of Education responsibilities, and other duties as assigned. Lecturers are required to: 1) be present in the iLounge for 2 hours per week, 2) act as writing center tutor for 1 hour per week, and 3) hold regular office hours for 1.5 hours per week. In addition, CEC lecturers are expected to be available for general student consultation while on campus as time and schedule permit.
